

### PIER Wildfire Response, Rural Capacity

- **PIER Selection Committee met on 11/2** recommended moving forward to OHCS grant application from Phoenix for Planning & Infrastructure.
- **Rural Capacity** grants expected for the current biennium to districts/councils of governments. \$5 m allocation (HB3395), support to housing.

- Plans to submit grant applications to Business Oregon for implementation funding.









  - Rural Capacity (partnership with RVCOG)
- Increase financial stability
  - Build loan program revenues
  - Continue investment strategy
  - Secure membership renewals and new members
  - Pursue enterprise zone management fees allowed by Oregon statute


