Recommendation to Support RCC SBDC Josephine County Child Care Business Accelerator Program

As recommended by the Executive Committee on August 27, 2024

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

SOREDI Transfer gift of \$10,000 to SOREDI Foundation to provide grant funds for participants who complete the RCC SBDC Childcare Business Accelerator Program. The program will focus on childcare provider business startups and expansions in Josephine County.

Objective:

Provide grants to childcare providers for purchase of equipment, materials and supplies needed to help open or expand their childcare provider business services. SOREDI will solicit matching funds from Josephine County employers to complement the SOREDI Foundation Funds, seeking \$2,500 employer match for each \$2,500 provided by SOREDI, enabling up to four full \$5,000 grant awards.

This is a Pilot program and will be evaluated after 12-18 months for success and potential continuation by RCC SBDC and the SOREDI Foundation Board.

SOREDI Foundation funds left unused for this purpose will remain in the SOREDI Foundation for other forms of entrepreneurial support. Matching funds are provided at the completion of the program when all conditions are met, which will generally eliminate the possibility of receiving matched funds that can t be used for this purpose.

Justification:

High need for additional childcare providers in Josephine County to meet employer needs, matching similar efforts in Grants Pass and Medford. See RCC SBDC handout.

By using the SOREDI Foundation 501c3, employer contributions will be considered a charitable expense, and this grant program fits a clear purpose of the Foundation:

- Provide resources for entrepreneurs to build and support a robust innovation ecosystem that is <u>coordinated with partner agencies</u>, offering cohesive services and scholarships.
- Ideal participants are individuals considering a new business, or who are in the early phases of operating a business owned and operated in Southern Oregon.
