Oregon InC is a public-private partnership that supports innovators to take new technologies from an idea to market, oversees Business Oregon's innovation programs, and is guided by Oregon's 10-Year Innovation Plan.

What is a Regional Innovation Hub?

Regional Innovation Hubs are partnerships that provide technical assistance, capital, networking, mentorship, and talent development to innovation-based entrepreneurs statewide. Regional Innovation Hub partnerships assist entrepreneurs with innovation-based business concepts across varied sectors, also serving as a regional network of service providers to build and grow a culture of innovation throughout Oregon's regions.

Why Innovation?

Regional Innovation Hubs are specifically focused on supporting the growth and development of high-growth, scalable, innovation-based companies primarily focused on science and technology. Covering a wide array of sectors, data shows innovation-based companies have the greatest impact on Oregonians' quality of life and economic resilience.
