Ladies and Gentlemen:

Southern Oregon Regional Economic Development, Inc. (SOREDI) asks for your strong and immediate financial support to the Oregon Shakespeare Festival (OSF) in Ashland.

SOREDI is the EDA designated Economic Development District for our region, and we house the region's Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy (CEDS), which we call our One Rogue Valley Strategy. This funding request for OSF is clearly connected to this Strategy within 4 of our 5 key initiatives:

- o INITIATIVE 1. BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT Ensure thoughtful, sustainable, and equitable economic growth by strategically promoting the region as a destination for business expansion and relocation.
- INITIATIVE 3. TALENT Invest in the ecosystem that attracts, equips, and retains a strong pipeline of talent to meet the long-term needs of current and future employers.
- INITIATIVE 4. TOURISM Support the organizations and places that strengthen the tourism and experiential environment in Southern Oregon.
- INITIATIVE 5. PLACEMAKING Nurture an environment that preserves Southern Oregon's quality of life for residents, businesses, and visitors.

OSF has long been a key performing arts venue in Ashland and the entire region, drawing visitors far and wide, who also visit other entertainment venues and recreational assets in and near our region, supporting additional tourism spending.

Following the pandemic, SOREDI received funding from EDA and we immediately passed through a \$150,000 sub-grant (37.5% of the EDA funding) to the Ashland Chamber of Commerce to fund a business diversification study. The hit to OSF and the region was substantial and required quick action on our part, as a small non-profit agency. We shared quickly and effectively.

We understand that OSF was omitted from the Legislature's 2023 funding measure. Please ensure now that OSF and the surrounding arts and entertainment businesses of Southern Oregon are recognized for their job creation, investments, and contribution to our regional economy with your kind attention to the OSF funding request and this letter of support.
