Anne Lundgren and her husband, Gary, founded the production company Joma Films in Ashland, Oregon. If you have ever wondered whether crowdfunding might be an appropriate resource for your start up venture, attend this LAUNCH|Talk and learn the basics from Lundgren. Her experience with a thirty day Kickstarter campaign taught her who to reach out, when to reach people and how to ask. Through Kickstarter, Lundgren recruited 365 backers for Black Road, gaining almost \$46,000 for the production. Your enterprise will benefit from hearing about her experience. You may be encouraged to engage in crowdfunding to support your own project.
